## 10. ADD A TABLE

We're going to change our My Favourite Books page so that it shows a table listing our top five books and showing marks out of ten for each of the books. Here's how it will look:



1. Start by adding the following selectors to your **simple.css** file:


Add the table to your **books.html page**. Here is some code to get you started:
